The Process



Initial Consultation

The initial consultation lasts 60 minutes and explores current concerns, including any mental health difficulties
The initial consultation is conducted with the client. We will then make a recommendation regarding the next steps

Background information

Information is collected relating to educational development and literacy skills. Relevant questionnaires are also sent to the client.

Dyslexia assessment

The client will need to complete a range of different tasks, looking at different aspects of cognitive processing and literacy skills:

- Phonological Awareness
- Phonological Memory
- Processing Speed
- Working Memory
- Verbal and Visual Reasoning Abilities
- Reading Accuracy and Comprehension
- Spelling and Writing

How can I be sure the dyslexia assessment is robust?

Our dyslexia assessments follow best practice guidance from the Specific Learning Difficulties Standards Committee (SASC, <https://sasc.org.uk/>), with an assessor who holds an up-to-date Assessment Practicing Certificate, demonstrating commitment to ongoing CPD (Continuing Professional Development) and high-quality assessment.

Can you have a dyslexia assessment by video call?

Yes, remote assessments for dyslexia were approved in 2020. One of the benefits of remote assessment is they take place in an environment you are relaxed in.
